Pay in full by January 31 to receive \$200 off tuition!

Pay in full by February 28 to receive \$100 off tuition!

Full payment is required two weeks after acceptance into the program. If you need to work out a payment plan, a non-refundable \$700 deposit (credited toward tuition) is required one week after acceptance to secure a student's place in the workshop with full payment due no later than two months from date of acceptance. **Any outstanding payments must be received by June 1, 2017.**
